"Error While Copying MySQL JDBC Driver"

I went into Synaptic and installed libmysql-java, then attempted to install Pachyderm again. Still no joy.

Scott,

I am searching for the Web root. The installation README says this:

Open a Web browser on the server and go
to <http://localhost:8080/Pachyderm21/WebObjects>

Nothing there. I open my Tomcat Manager to view installed applications and it does not show up there either. And yet, I didn't get any errors when installing. Going to check to make sure files were copied to filesystem, DB was created and populated in MySQL...

Forwarded from the developer... You may be able to work around this.

If you run the installer from the terminal with `java -jar PachydermInstaller.jar` (whatever the appropriate name for the installer jar is), output can be seen on the terminal window. Other than that, there is no logging.

The installer probably doesn't have permission to write to the Tomcat lib directory so it cannot copy the mysql driver into place. It probably should have been written by the idiot author o just continue on and give a message at the end saying to manually copy the jar file into place.

I'll fix that up for the next release.

Getting closer!

Tomcat was not where the Pachyderm installer thought it was, so I explicitly changed the path on the Pachyderm installer to point to where my actual (Synaptic-installed) Tomcat is and reinstalled. Success. I bounced Tomcat, then booted up the Tomcat Manager, and there is a Pachyderm app present.

However, when I click on it, or when I go to <http://localhost:8080/pachyderm> I get:

The requested resource (/pachyderm2/) is not available.

Not sure where that "2" is coming from; I explicitly deleted version numbers from e.g., paths, etc., during the install process. Maybe something is hardcoded?

Going to reinstall now, yet leave all defaults (except path to Tomcat, that is) and see what happens....

OK, mid-afternoon update:

I dropped the DB and deleted the User from MySQL.

I deleted any directory tree associated with this exercise, leftover from any previous install.

I manually created, while root, the following directories:

```
/var/lib/tomcat6/webapps/Pachyderm21
/var/lib/tomcat6/webapps/pachyderm_2_1
/var/lib/tomcat6/webapps/resources
/usr/local/lib/ApplicationSupport
```

(/var/lib/tomcat6 is where my Tomcat is installed. It was installed by the Synaptic package manager in Ubuntu.)

I, again as root, booted up the installer and followed the directions. Oddly, when it got toward the end it asked me: "Not all of the paths you have chosen exist. Do you want to create those directories that do not exist?" And this, even though I had manually created them previously. Nevertheless, I clicked Yes on this.

All went well; no error messages of any kind.

I rebooted Tomcat.

I opened the Tomcat Manager to see if a new app was present. It was: Pachyderm21

I clicked on it, and this is what I got:
